Wanted: Manufacturers looking to reduce waste and save money

MMA-MEP is offering a limited number of manufacturing sustainability assessments at **no cost** to qualifying Mississippi manufacturers. The free assessments are made possible by a grant from the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ).

The E3 assessment is a collaborative process. The company must be willing to commit the time and key personnel to work with the Mississippi E3 team. Company involvement includes the completion of a pre-assessment survey, participation in a one-day on-site assessment visit and a follow-up briefing to discuss the final report, and completion of a post-assessment impact survey.

Eligibility:

- Mississippi Manufacturer
- No more than 500 employees
- NAICS Code beginning with 31, 32, or 33

What to Expect:

- Analysis of annual energy bills and expenditures.
- Energy and cost savings recommendations unique to your facility.
- Report with recommended projects and their respective energy savings and implementation costs.
